The PGWPP allows students who have graduated from designated Canadian learning institutions to obtain an open work permit to gain valuable Canadian work experience. Skilled real-world training gained through the PGWPP helps graduates qualify for permanent residence in Canada through the Canadian Experience Class within Express Entry.

AAIP is an economic immigration program that nominates people for permanent residence in Alberta. Nominees must have skills to fill job shortages or be planning to buy or start a business in Alberta.

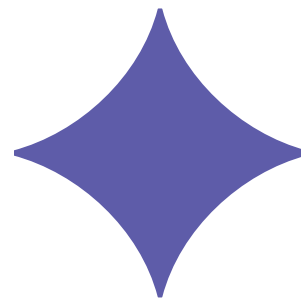

Entrance scholarships

International students are eligible to apply for scholarships in this category if:

- They are starting their very first post-secondary program at Bow Valley College.
- They have already completed and graduated from a first post-secondary program at Bow Valley College, and are now starting a second post-secondary program.
- They have completed an English language learning or upgrading program at Bow Valley College, and are now starting a post-secondary program.

In-Course scholarships

International students are eligible to apply for scholarships in this category if:

- They are current Bow Valley College full-time students in good academic standing, and have already completed at least one academic term in their post-secondary program.

CEA Diploma Scholarship

The scholarship is based on Portfolio Assessment and will be applied to tuition evenly at the start of each term in the program.

Apply to scholarships**

Students who are ready to explore open scholarships and submit their application can apply through the scholarships portal, bvcawards.awardspring.ca

Application deadlines:

- Scholarships open on the first day of class, each academic term, and close approximately six weeks after.

Important notes:

- Students can apply for more than one open scholarship, as long as they meet the eligibility criteria.
- To apply for both Entrance and In-Course scholarships students must have courses registered for the academic term in which they are applying.
- After scholarships have closed, the reviewing committee has one month to assess applications and communicate with successful candidates.

*The Foundation in Entertainment Arts certificate has no scholarship, only 2-year diploma programs are qualified for scholarship.

**CEA scholarships: no application needed for the CEA scholarship, it is based on the portfolio submitted with the application.

Program Structure

The International English Language Learning program offers five levels. Each level costs approximately \$4,957 per semester. Your initial level placement can be determined by submitting a valid English language proficiency exam result (IELTS Academic, Duolingo, TOEFL, or Pearson PTE)*. The level placement will be based on the lowest band score of the official English proficiency exam result (except TOEFL iBT).

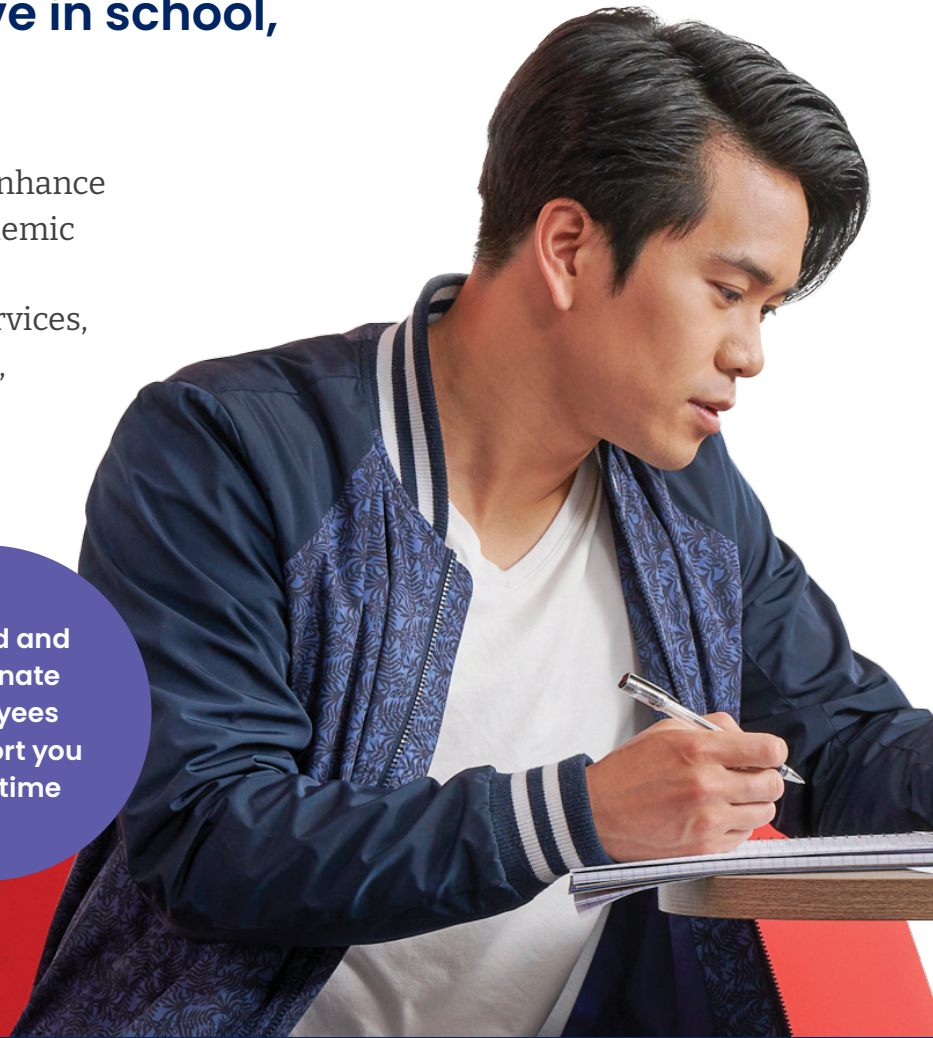

Conditional Acceptance: If you are still completing courses that you need in order to meet the admission requirements for a career program, you may still submit an application. The Admissions Officer will request to see proof of enrolment in required courses, including the course completion dates. Final grades that meet the entrance requirements must be submitted by the deadline outlined in the conditional acceptance letter to confirm acceptance into the program.

We strongly recommend applying a minimum of 12 months before the date of your desired intake. It is very important to ensure that there is sufficient time for processing your study permit application before confirming your start date.
