

How to turn on Select to Speak on Android Phones/Tablets

Note: Please be aware that every phone/tablet is a bit different any may be running a different version of Android. These instructions are designed to help you find the right area to turn on Select to Speak, but the screenshots and instructions may be a bit different on your device.





How to use Select to Speak on Android phone/tablets.

	When Select to Speak is turned on a speech bubble icon will appear at the bottom of your screen. The speech bubble will remain on the
	screen unless you turn Select to Speak off.
4 0 □	If you want to move the speech bubble icon , tap and hold your finger on the screen until you feel a slight vibration, then drag the icon around your screen.
	You can use the speech bubble to read aloud any text that you can tap on such as documents, emails, text messages, text on websites and text labels
	When you wish to hear spoken text, first tap on the speech bubble icon . The icon will change colour to indicate that Select to Speak is ready.
1 ■ ± ▷	Next, tap an item on the screen or drag your finger over the text to select it.
This is an example of text-to-speech using Google Docs. To hear text read aloud, tap the text-to-speech icon and then tap on an	The text will become highlighted and your text will be read aloud.
item or drag your finger over several items. The text currently being read aloud will be highlighted.	Tap anywhere on the screen to stop reading.
